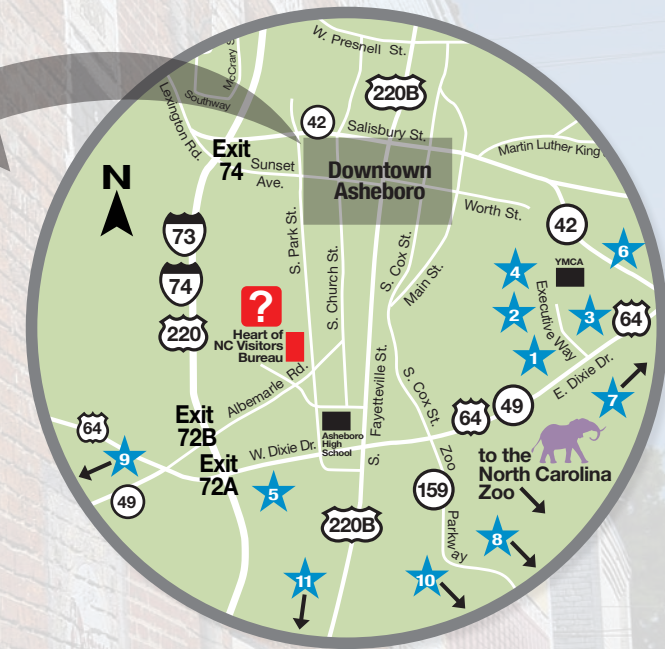
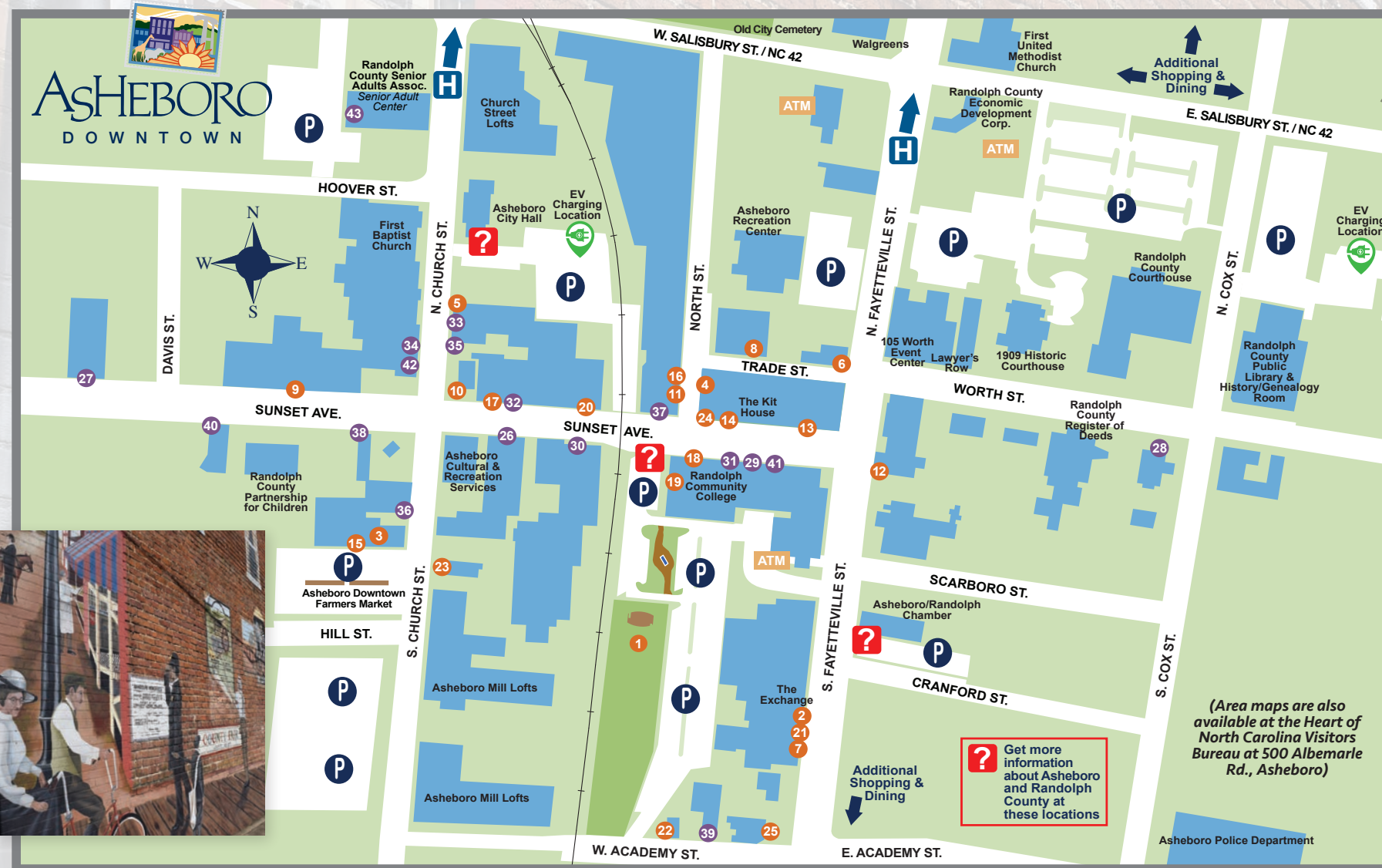

The Zoo City Social District is open on **Thursday, Friday, and Saturday between the hours of 11:00am and 11:00pm** on each of the listed days.
