A YEAR IN REVIEW

& SUCCESSES ALONG THE WAY

It has been another exciting year for downtown Asheboro, and each week, it seems there is something new to enjoy in the district. Many years of hard work and dedication have paid off, and it is exciting for growth and opportunity to blossom in the heart of our local economy.

As the NC Main Street program administrator for Asheboro, Downtown Asheboro Inc. (DAI) has continued our mission of creating a vibrant downtown by promoting economic development through historic preservation. Since our program inception in 2020, we have helped foster over \$13 million in private investment in our downtown district, resulting in a net gain of 11 businesses, 29 full-time jobs, and 31 part-time jobs. This year, we welcomed 50 new residential units to our downtown footprint in the Church Street Lofts, saw 3 buildings completely renovated, and 5 facades improved. Our promotional efforts, including the Friday Night Rock'n the Park concert series, brought over 15,000 visitors to our downtown district from across the region. This impact wouldn't be possible without the community stakeholders who have invested their time and efforts into the community, volunteering over 1,450 hours since 2020.

At the heart of it all, downtown Asheboro is a place where friends can gather, family can enjoy each other's company, and our community can find inspiration at every corner. We are proud of how far we have come, and we look forward to all the unlimited possibilities of the future.

- Welcome travel writers and content creators to downtown Asheboro for promotional pieces on the district

- Facilitate the design and installation of the animal footprint crosswalks
- · Begin the conceptual work for the Trade Street Streetscape Project

- Administer the Downtown Asheboro Redevelopment Grant to respond to building inventory needs
- · Collaborate with the City of Asheboro to secure the Acme McCrary Mill site for historic preservation
